Supplementary Regulations

Announcement.

Sporting Car Club of Norfolk will organise and promote a dual permit Clubmans Grass Production Car Autotest (PCA) and Autotest (AT) on Sunday 3rd August 2025 at Snetterton Circuit, Norfolk NR16 2JU (enter via Map Ref: 144 / 007¹/₂ 896).

1 Jurisdiction.

The event will be governed by the general regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any further written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

2 Authorisations.

Motorsport UK Clubmans permit numbers tbc & tbc have been issued.

3 Competitor Eligibility.

The entry is open to members of the organising clubs and members of the member clubs of Anglia Motor Sport Club (AMSC).

ALL PARTIPANTS WILL NEED A MOTORSPORT UK LICENCE EITHER 2025 RS CLUBMAN OR 2025 RS INTER CLUB (formerly NatB)

4 Programme.

5 Classes.

The event will consist of two classes:

E	PCA (passenger required)
D	AT (No passenger permitted)

6 Double Drive.

To help with pre-event documentation please indicate on the entry form if the entry is part of a double drive entry, a double drive involves either the car, the driver or the passenger being involved in the event more than once.

REMINDER each entry requires a fully completed entry form – a straight forward double drive will require the submission of two entry forms.

7 Awards.

There may be awards.

8 Entries.

The maximum entry for the event is 40, the minimum is 6.

Entries open at 6pm on Friday 11th July 2025 and close at 6pm on Wednesday 30th July 2025.

The entry fee is £20 per driver, free if the driver is under 18.

The club is supporting the Snetterton Local Residents Open Evening on the evening of Wednesday 13th August by organising an Autotest Demonstration Event to be held on the 100-circuit car park, volunteer drivers and marshals are required, anyone signing up to help on the Demonstration can claim a free entry to the Grass PCA.

All entries must be made using the on-line entry form (link on the website).

The entry fee to be paid in cash on the day.

The plan is to donate £5 from each entry fee collected to the Micra Maintenance kitty.

12 Route, Format & Penalties.

The entire event will take place within the confines of Snetterton Circuit.

The event will comprise of 4 tests.

M15 (a)	details of the tests will be included in the pre-event documentation
M15 (b)	each driver will have 3 runs at each test – BEST 2 times to count
M15 (c)	drivers will be identified by numbers (A5) which will be included in the pre-event documentation
M15 (d)	timing will be by hand held stop watches to the previous tenth of a second
M15 (e)	the starting signal will be 'in your own time'

Performance will be assessed as in Table M.7- PCA.

13 Modifications to the General Regulations.

All other General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association apply, except for the following which are modified:

M6	posts or pylons may be less than 1 metre high

14 Judges of Fact.

All signed on Marshals and Timekeepers are Judges of Fact to adjudicate in accordance with M8.

15 Final Instructions.

Final Instructions will be emailed during the week prior to the event, to the email address provided on the entry form.

16 Minimum Ages.

Entries may be accepted from drivers who are 14 and over. However, for drivers not holding a full RTA Licence, the passenger must hold a full RTA Licence and be experienced in Autotesting.

Passengers must be 12 years or over. However, for passengers not holding a full RTA Licence, the driver must hold a full RTA Licence.

17 Micras.

The club Micras will be available for drivers who do not have a suitable car.

Club Micras must be booked on the entry form.

18 Marshals.

Marshals, please register using the on-line registration form (link on the website).

19 Catering.

Hot & cold drinks may be available from the club trailer, bring your own pack ups.

20 Toilets.

Toilets will be available on site.

21 Animals.

No animals allowed on site.
